TEXTS: Feathered Star Quilt Blocks I by Marsha McCloskey, and Pieced Borders by Judy Martin and Marsha McCloskey.

18" C-THRU drawing ruler (B-85)*, sharp pencil, eraser, colored pencils, compass.

3 Large sheets of 1/8" graph paper will be provided in class for 25¢ per sheet.

Rotary cutter with new blade, cutting mat, and rulers (bring what you have: I recommend the 8" Bias Square cutting ruler from Martingale, a 6" x 24" ruler, 3" x 18" ruler and a 15" square.)

Fabric: a variety of prints: stripes, plaids, florals (large and small) -- fat quarters to 1-1/2 yard pieces. We'll be striving for a scrappy look, so bring lots of fabrics making sure that light (backgrounds!), medium and dark values are well represented.

Sewing machine and normal sewing supplies

Small zip-lock bags

1 -1/2 yards of white flannel or appropriate batting for design wall.

*NOTE about the 18" C-THRU drawing ruler (B-85): This is a thinner ruler than a rotary cutting ruler. It is 18" long and 2" wide, and has a 1/8" grid printed in red. C-THRU is the brand name. B-85 is the product number. This ruler is generally available in stationery stores. Quilt stores generally sell a similar "Quilt and Sew Ruler" for a slightly higher price -- this ruler is also appropriate. Some will be available for purchase in class for \$4.50.
