

# The Make It Simpler® No-waste Windmill Supply List

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- Fabric, starched
- Square ruler 6 ½" to true-up block
- Square ruler at least 7½"
- Medium rectangular ruler at least 9" long x 2" wide
- Spray starch (regular, not heavy)
- Medium point permanent marker such as a Sharpie
- Scissors, pins, rotary cutter, gridded medium-sized rotary mat
- Pen, paper and camera for notes; seam ripper
- Sewing machine set up with a new needle, thread, ¼" presser foot, and, if necessary, extension cord
- Adhesive: Either 3M Scotch Restickable *or* Collins brand Glue Stick OR Removable Double-coated tape
- Instrument to mark rotary mat: a washable dark marker or washable light-colored pencil
- Post-It Notes: 1½" x 1-7/8" pad
- Fleece or suitable design wall fabric to cover QBL 4' x 8' foam core sheet
- Anita's 2010 rotary cutting book is optional; any necessary photocopies will be provided at cost



## Fabric

As many different fabrics as you wish. Scraps must measure least 8" on each side. Fabric needn't be strictly light vs dark but a quilt entirely of medium value fabric won't be as effective. Avoid thin white fabric; contrasting fabric may shadow underneath it. Fabric used in the bordering blocks should be determined after the interior blocks are sewn and arranged. The Windmill blocks are 6 ½" unfinished; 6" finished. 1 square of fabric makes one block.
