

Finishing School

Supply List:

- Minimum five quilt sandwiches of fat quarter size
- Minimum ten assorted fat quarter of fabric. As these are for samples they can be older pieces from your stash
- Assorted threads to include general sewing threads and also a small number of decorative threads such as rayon or polyester
- Beads, braids, ric-rac and other assorted trims and decorative items
- Sewing machine with all accessories including your slide on tray table and knee bar if you have one. A straight stitch plate is also useful (and please pop in your instruction manual)
- Quarter inch foot
- Piping or zipper foot
- Free-motion foot (open toe style is best)
- Cutting mat
- Rotary cutter
- Long ruler
- 1" x 6" ruler
- General sewing kit to include scissors for fabric and paper, hand and machine needles, pins, etc.
- Small roll of freezer paper
- Notebook, pencils and paper
- OPTIONAL: open-toe satin stitch foot, bendy rule, a small/medium sized quilt that has been quilted and is ready to have the edges finished
- I will bring the piping cord and other sundries for the class and a small charge will be made for these
