

# Supply List

## Crazy Beading

Taught by Nancy Eha

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**2 day workshop**, all experience levels, no sewing machines needed

**Kit fee: \$30** includes all beads, thread, needles, patterns, instructional materials, and assorted supplies.

## Supply List

**Students should bring to workshop:**

### **Fabric: Crazy Quilt Block**

Construct a 10 or 12 inch Crazy Quilt block onto a muslin or light colored flannel base.

Segments should be rather large, as beading takes up more space than floss, etc. Segments should be no smaller than 5" x 3".

Use solid fabrics or tone on tone for most segments. Use patterned fabric sparingly. You can construct the block with cottons or fancy fabric. If you have not made a crazy quilt block before, there are numerous books available to help you or search on line for instructions. They are also in Nancy's book, Bead Creative Like Crazy.

### **Supplies:**

1. Optional CQ Block (see above) **OR** a 12" square of muslin, or cotton to bead on as a sampler.
2. A few straight pins
3. Small sharp scissors or embroidery scissors
4. Paper scissors
5. Cool Whip size lid or small non-segmented hard white plate to bead off, or Velux beading cloth
6. Glasses if needed for handwork
7. Personal lamp with extension cord
8. Power strip to share
