

The Make It Simpler® Arrowhead Quilt Supply List

- Square ruler: 9 ½" (or larger)
- Optional square rulers: 3½"; 8"
The 8 inch square ruler from "That Patchwork Place" is optional but *recommended*
- Optional rectangular rulers 3½" x 9½"; 2" x at least 8"
- Medium point permanent marker such as a Sharpie
- Scissors, pins, rotary cutter, medium-sized rotary mat
- Pen, paper and camera for note; seam ripper; painter's masking tape
- Sewing machine set up with a new needle, thread, ¼" presser foot, and, if necessary, extension cord
- Post-It Notes: 1½" x 1-7/8" pad
- Fleece or suitable design wall fabric to cover QBL 4' x 8' foam core sheet
- Anita's 2010 rotary cutting book is optional;
any necessary photocopies will be provided at cost



Fabric

As many different fabrics as you wish. Fabric needn't be strictly light vs dark but a quilt made *entirely* of medium value fabric won't be as effective. Avoid thin white fabric; contrasting fabric may shadow underneath it.

Preparation

Laundered and **starched** fabric to be cut **in class** into 8" squares. Absolutely, positively, do NOT pre-cut 8" squares at home. You may bring any size pieces of fabric, including miscellaneous scraps, but all must measure at least 8 ½" on each side.

Arrowhead blocks are 9" unfinished; 8½" finished. 2 squares of fabric make one block.
