**Class # 22: Water-Based Resists**

**Supply list:**

**dust mask** that fits your face

several pairs of latex gloves (throwaway type)

**cutting mat**

**craft and fabric scissors**

**pins and pincushion**

**several small containers** [yogurt type or baby food jars (for mixing dyes)] These will be contributed to the group effort.

**small food scraper** (sometimes called a "spatula") to scoop dye from containers

**#11 blade exacto knife** (NO other) small barrel knife is easier to use than a bigger barrel version.

**selection of foam & bristle brushes** - 1" - 3", natural and synthetic ok.

paint roller – foam or standard type

1 yard NON fusible, nonwoven interfacing. Pellon medium weight is a good choice.

gloves and apron - preferably vinyl reusable gloves **and not latex throwaways**

**1 small bucket** approx 1 gallon size . We may not need this but it depends entirely on the situation and better to have it than not.

pen/notebook

**duct tape** (Duck brand is really good) (sometimes 3m brand doesn't stick)

1 box of freezer paper

2" wide masking tape

1 bottle of Elmer's blue school glue

**old towel** for clean up. We use as few throwaways as possible, hence, no paper towels. This will be contributed to the group effort.

**1 yard of muslin or an old sheet** to cover existing work surface

1 yard craft felt – any color

8 oz bottle of Golden or Liquitex brand matte medium

textured objects and appropriated tools to make marks – stuff like bubble wrap, corrugated cardboard, plastic net, scrapers. this will all be experimental.

**PLEASE READ THIS ADVICE COMPLETELY. YOU WILL BE SO MUCH HAPPIER WITH YOUR SAMPLES IF YOU ABIDE BY THESE SUGGESTIONS.**

**FABRIC to bring:**

**Total needed: 3 - 4 yards**

Sizing greatly affects the dye process and you need PFD fabrics. PREWASH ALL FABRIC.

Order cloth from Dharma Trading Company, Testfabrics, Exotic Silks, or Rupert, Gibbon, and Spider.

Order:

2 yards silk habotai 12mm weight.

ALSO: your choice of Silk broadcloth, charmeuse, silk noil, rayon or white cotton – equivalent of 2 more yards, any combination.

**Silkscreen.** # C43422-1004. 10" x 14" wooden frame silkscreen with 12xx polyester mesh. 11.49
