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Are you looking for a fun and creative way to combine a multitude of colored and patterned fabrics? Join us in layering and cutting back intriguing combinations of quilting cottons. Create your very own design and listen to your heart rather than your head. You will emerge from this class with an exciting and original art quilt and countless ideas for future projects!

Techniques covered: machine cut-back appliqué, machine embellishments, some hand-embellishments optional. Basic color theory and sound design principles are an integral part of this workshop.

Supply List

- Assorted quilting cottons (aim to bring 5 Fat Quarters in contrasting and complimentary colors). *Please note:* batiks without specific motives and hand-dyed cottons work well; start with your favorite fabric and select 4 more FQs
- Sewing machine in good working order with accessories
- Extra needles
- Threads to go with your fabric choices
- Batting of your choice (approx. 1/2 meter/yd)
- One Fat Quarter or a little more for backing fabric
- Scissors for fabric and paper
- Freezer paper
- Paper backed fusible (1/2 meter/yd)
- Cutting mat, ruler, rotary cutter
- Note book, pen and pencil
- Last but not least: an open mind
