Machine Quilting Essentials

Supply List for Students:

- Sewing Machine- bring instruction manual, all accessories and sewing machine extension bar or table.
- Darning foot- a must for free motion quilting
- Walking foot- bring if you have one, if not use regular presser foot
- Straight stitch throat plate-optional, bring if you have one
- Twelve 10" squares muslin
- Six 10" squares cotton or cotton blend batting
- 50 safety pins (I use size 0 or 1)
- *please note- you may use another method of basting- spray basting or fusible batting.
- *also note- basting of samples and project will be done in the workshop
- Sewing machine needles- 80/12 & 70/10 microtex sharp or machine quilting
- Transparent nylon or polyester thread- clear, .004 weight (I use YLI)
- Cotton thread- off white and tan, 50 weight (3 ply or 2 ply)
- Marking pencil- silver (I use Quilters Choice brand)
- Ruler- for marking straight lines
- Rubber Gloves- kitchen dishwashing gloves, one size smaller than you wear for dishwashing (I use fingers for control)
- Basic sewing supplies- scissors, bobbins, hand sewing needles, etc.
- Extension cord
- Optional, but a good idea- small cushion for height, extra light

Small project:

18" square solid (or tone on tone) 100% cotton fabric

22" square backing 100% cotton fabric (I use matching small print)

22" square batting (I use cotton or cotton blend)

Thread for project

Stencil will be provided -\$8.00 fee
