

## Creative Machine Quilting: Enhancing the Surface

### Supply list

Machine in good working order and able to drop the feed dogs

A darning foot

Walking foot or dual feed

Threads-

Cotton 40 wt. and/or 50wt. in any color that will contrast with your background cloth

Polyester regular 50 wt. thread that will contrast with background cloth

Decorative thread you may have on hand i.e.: metallic, 40 wt. rayon

Heavy Weight threads to put in the bobbin such as: Madeira Glamour, YLI

Candlelight, Pearl Crown Rayon

Yarn or braid scraps for couching

(If you don't have some of these, I will be bringing some for you to use.)

Needles:

Universal 10 or 12

Topstitch 12

Microtex 12, (10)

Marking:

HB mechanical pencil

Old credit card or Hera marker

Wash away fabric marker

Cloth:

**Make ahead of time the following:** 20 quilt sandwiches, 8" square, using muslin or solid color cotton on the front and back. Any kind of batting is fine, just not too thick.

3-4 empty bobbins

Optional: Extra bobbin case if you have one (used with heavier threads)

Small scissors or thread snips

Safety pins to pin quilt layers (about 12)

Notebook: 1 1/2" is good

Clear plastic sheet protectors (about 10) for the notebook

If you want: A quilt top that is waiting to be quilted and you want some help on what to do.
