Course Description:

David Hornung's color workshop is an intensive version of the curriculum he developed while teaching at the Rhode Island School of Design. It is based on his book, *Colour: A workshop for artists and designers*.

Classwork is designed to help students explore fundamental color theory and apply it to a series of small painted paper collages culminating in "free studies" where each student gets the opportunity to experiment in ways that relate to their personal art or design inclinations. This course accommodates students at all levels and requires no painting experience.

Also, bring along a water container (a glass jar is perfect), paper towels, a steel rule, a pencil, a "self-healing" rubber cutting mat and a utility knife.
